It is not just Millennials who are [struggling](#) with housing costs. A new survey shows Baby Boomers are also worried about paying rent and affording their homes.

The NHP Foundation [survey](#) said one-third of Americans aged 55 and up worry about being able to afford their home at least once a month, [ConstructionDive reports](#). Retirees are even more worried. The survey said 42% are concerned on a daily basis. Nearly 65% of Baby Boomers are worried their adult children will not be able to afford housing.
