Dear Residents.

In an effort to help our staff as winter snowstorms approach, we are asking all of our residents to do their part to ensure a quick cleanup of the property during snow removal. Please keep the following tips in mind whenever the forecast calls for snow:

- 1. Remove all welcome mats from front doorways and any decorations that may get in the way of our snow removal team. Doormats, Newspapers and other items can become tangled in our snow blowers and cause damage to the equipment and slow down the removal process. 
